

**2010 ABEAB 38**

**Appeal No. 10-009**

**Appellants** – Michael Dockman and Prairie Royale Water System Ltd., **Operator** – Prairie Royale Water System Ltd., **Location** – Airdrie, Alberta, **Type of Appeal** – Discontinuance

A Notice of Appeal was received on June 28, September 3 and September 17, 2010 from Michael Dockman in relation to the June 3, 2010 decision of Alberta Environment to issue *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* Administrative Penalty No. 10/12-AP-SR-10/15 to Michael Dockman and Prairie Royale Water System Ltd. in the amount of \$8,500. Alberta Environment stated the Appellant contravened the Potable Water Regulation by exceeding the maximum acceptable concentration for free chlorine, by being below the minimum acceptable concentration for total chlorine, and by having fluoride levels exceed the maximum acceptable concentration for a water system located at E ½ 33-25-28-W4M, in the Municipal District of Rocky View No. 44.

In consultation with the participants, a mediation meeting was held on December 14, 2010 in Calgary. As a result of the resolution reached at the mediation, the appeal was withdrawn and the Board closed its file.
