DISMISSAL ORDER

- [1] The Applicant filed an application with the Condominium Authority Tribunal (CAT). The case proceeded to Mediation in and around April 14, 2021.

That means that the Users cannot share, or tell anyone about, messages or documents they received from other Users during these stages without the permission of the other User.

3. The Users may share a copy of any document they received during the course of this case if required by law, such as to a government organization or a court.
