WITHDRAWAL ORDER

 Mediation of this case are private and confidential. That means that the Users cannot share, or tell anyone about, messages or documents they received from other Users without the permission of the other User.
- 3. The Users may share a copy of any document they received during the course of this case if required by law, such as to a government organization or a court.
