## **CONSENT ORDER**

- 3. The Applicant shall provide access to his unit for the purpose of this investigation;
- 4. Christine Sapsford shall provide access to her unit for the purpose of this investigation;
- 5. All parties shall cooperate with Mr. Colalillo in his investigation, provide any information or documents requested by his provided the information is within the party's knowledge and /or the documentation is within their possession. No party shall interfere with his investigation
- 6. A copy of Michael Colalillo's report shall be provided to all parties that have provided the property manager for SCC60 with the email address that they wish the report to be sent to
- 7. There will no order for costs in this Application

## **COMPLIANCE**

[5] If any of the Parties fails to comply with any of the terms of this order, it may be enforced through the Ontario Superior Court of Justice.
