# **ORDER**

- 2. Any documents and messages that have been shared for this case in Stage 1 – Negotiation, Stage 2 – Mediation and/or the Stage 3 – Mediation/Adjudication are private and confidential. That means that the parties cannot share, or tell anyone about, messages or documents they received from the other party during these stages without the permission of the other party.
- 3. The parties may share a copy of any document they received during the course of this case if required by law, such as to a government organization or a court.
