**UNLOCATABLE COPYRIGHT OWNER**

**Non-exclusive licence issued to Daniel G. Arnold, Ottawa, Ontario authorizing the reproduction of quotes from an article published in *Saturday Review***

Pursuant to the provisions of subsection 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*, the Copyright Board grants a licence to Daniel G. Arnold as follows:

- (1) The licence authorizes the reproduction, in a forthcoming book dealing with wartime real property confiscations, of two quotes from the article titled "American Loyal to the Crown" written by Richard Brandon Morris (1904-1989) published in the December 18, 1965, issue of the *Saturday Review* magazine, Volume 48, No. 51. The relevant quotes are on file at the Copyright Board.
- (2) The licence expires on December 31, 2010. The authorized reproduction must therefore be completed by that date.
- (3) The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.
- (4) The issuance of the licence does not release the licensee from the obligation to obtain permission for any other use not covered by this licence.
- (5) The licensee will pay the sum of \$10 to any person (other than the author for whose rights permission was obtained from his estate) who establishes, before December 31, 2015, ownership of copyright in the *Saturday Review* magazine.
- (6) The coming into force of this licence is conditional on the licensee filing with the Board his undertaking to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph (5) above.
