**Abandonment near Mayerthorpe  
Licence 5341

**Record amendment application**

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission to amend the pipe status of Line 34 in Township 56, Range 6, west of the Fifth Meridian from “operating” to “abandoned.”

The proposed amendment in Application 20078-A001 registered on January 21, 2015 and filed under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 5341.

ATCO stated that after reviewing its records, it was determined that the abandonment for Line 34 was not applied for within 90 days of the work completion date and therefore has missed the 90 day notification window allowed by the Commission. The purpose of this application is to correct this oversight.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
