Record Amendment to Pipelines within the Edmonton Area Licence 3861 Proceeding 20335 Application 20335-A001

Record amendment application

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 20335-A001 registered on April 8, 2015, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the pipeline wall thickness of lines 11 and 51 in the Edmonton area from 7.10 millimetres (mm) to 7.14 mm. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 3861.
- 2. ATCO stated that upon further review of its records, it determined that the pipeline wall thickness of lines 11 and 51 is incorrectly stated as 7.10 mm and should be corrected to be 7.14 mm. As a result of the change in wall thickness, the stress level changes from 49 per cent to 48 per cent.
- 3. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 4. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
- 5. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
