Record Amendment to the Wildwood Pipeline in the Drayton Valley Area Licence 34000 Proceeding 20336 Application 20336-A001

Record amendment application

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 20336-A001 registered on April 8, 2015 filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Townships 50 and 51, Ranges 8 and 9, west of the Fifth Meridian:
 - Mapping amendment of Line 2.
 - Length amendment of Line 2 from 16.19 kilometres to 15.48 kilometres.
- 2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 34000.
- 3. ATCO stated that during a review of its records it was determined that, after the pipeline licence was granted, there had been a change in the pipeline route. A portion of the pipeline was re-routed to avoid a permanent sample plot identified by Alberta Environmental Protection in 2001, which affected the actual position and length of Line 2.
- 4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 5. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
