Pipe Wall Thickness Amendment Near Bragg Creek Licence 14058 Proceeding 20367 Application 20367-A001

Minor pipeline project application

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 20367-A001 registered on April 20, 2015, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the pipe wall thickness of Line 22 from 5.6 millimetres to 5.5 millimetres. The proposed minor pipe wall thickness amendment applies to a pipeline recently approved for construction in Licence 14058.
- 2. ATCO stated that upon its review of the licence information, the pipe wall thickness of Line 22 should be amended from 5.6 millimetres to 5.5 millimetres.
- 3. ATCO has provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the amendment. Since the amendment involves no ground disturbance and is within the original right-of-way, the resultant environmental impact of the work has been assessed with no impact identified. The landowners and occupants of the affected lands did not object to the project.
- 4. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no person other than the landowners and occupants of the land upon which the project takes place will likely be directly affected by the proposal, and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed amendment.

5. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
