## **Record amendment application**

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610923 registered on October 17, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the status of Line 19 in Township 56, Range 22, west of the Fourth Meridian from "discontinued" to "abandoned". The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and subsequently removed from service in accordance with approvals granted in Licence No. 6419.

ATCO stated that after reviewing its records, it was determined that cathodic protection was not maintained on this pipeline at the time it was discontinued. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licence to accurately reflect the status of this pipeline as abandoned in place.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
