**Proposed Amendment to Pipelines along Highway 14 near Edmonton
Licence 6762
Proceeding 21241
Application 21241-A001**

Record amendment application

1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 21241-A001 registered on January 7, 2016, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in the Edmonton area:

- splitting Line 3 into lines 3 and 21
- splitting Line 4 into lines 4 and 22
- splitting Line 5 into lines 5 and 23
- reflecting the status of lines 5, 21 and 22 as abandoned
- addition of unlicensed lines 24, 25 and 26 which were constructed in 1974
- lines 3, 4 and 23 are to remain as operating

2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 6762.

3. ATCO stated that portions of lines 3, 4 and 5 were relocated to accommodate the widening of Highway 14 in 1974. This involved the abandonment of lines 5, 21 and 22; and the construction of lines 24, 25 and 26 to replace lines 21, 22 and 5, respectively. A licence amendment application was not completed at that time to reflect these changes. In order to correct this error, ATCO proposed to make the above listed amendments to Licence 6762.

4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

5. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
