## **Record amendment application**

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 21719-A001 registered on June 14, 2016, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the pipe status of line 3, in the Fort Saskatchewan area, from operating to abandoned. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 15386.
- 2. ATCO stated that the application is related to the abandonment of a one-kilometre long 88.9-millimetre transmission pipeline as part of the Scotford Expansion Project approved in Decision 3563-D01-2015. Line 3 was abandoned in accordance with the requirements of Rule 020: *Rules Respecting Gas Utility Pipelines*.
- 3. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 4. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
