**Ardrossan Transmission Pipeline in the City of Edmonton**  
**Licence 1724**  
**Proceeding 21722**  
**Application 21722-A001**

**Record amendment**

1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 21722-A001 registered on June 14, 2016, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in the city of Edmonton:

- pipe status amendment of line 24 from operating to abandoned
- mapping amendment of line 24

2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 1724.

3. ATCO stated that it received approval from the Commission in Decision DA2014-85,<sup>1</sup> to complete relocation of the 508-millimetre Ardrossan transmission pipeline to accommodate construction of the northeast Edmonton portion of Anthony Henday Drive, located within Edmonton's transportation utility corridor, at 130th Avenue and Meridian Street. That approval, which involved a line split, removal and new construction, also indicated that line 24 was to be abandoned in place.

4. ATCO stated that, after reviewing its records, it was determined that line 24 of Licence 1724 was abandoned in September of 2014, and therefore has missed the 90 day notification window allowed by the AUC. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licence to accurately reflect the record of this pipeline.

5. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

6. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
7. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
