Bittern Lake Transmission Pipeline Licence 52 Proceeding 22081 Application 22081-A001

Record amendment

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 22081-A001 registered on October 17, 2016, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in the Fort Saskatchewan area:
 - length amendment of line 25 from 1.97 kilometres (km) to the revised length of 2.03 km
 - length amendment of line 34 from 1.30 km to the revised length of 1.14 km
 - length amendment of line 35 from 1.38 km to the revised length of 1.48 km
- 2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 52.
- 3. ATCO stated that it received approval in Decision DA2014-95,¹ to complete the relocation of the 168.3-millimetre Bittern Lake Transmission Pipeline. This would accommodate the future infrastructure development necessary for the installation of a propane dehydrogenation facility.
- 4. ATCO proposed to amend the lengths as per "as built" information. The base maps are correct and no mapping amendment is required.
- 5. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

- 6. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
