Appendix 1 to DA2012-43 AltaGas Holdings Inc. Transfer Ownership of the Coaldale Power Plant	Application No. 1608114 Proceeding ID No. 1708

Maxim Power Corp. (Maxim), pursuant to Approval No. [U2007-243](#),¹ has approval to operate the Coaldale power plant in the Coaldale, Alberta area.

By Application No. 1608114 registered on February 1, 2012, AltaGas Holdings Inc., as a partner of AltaGas Pipeline Partnership, notified the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) that Maxim agreed to sell the power plant to AltaGas Pipeline Partnership pursuant to an Asset Acquisition Agreement dated January 25, 2012. AltaGas Holdings Inc. applied to hold the power plant approval in its name.

The Commission, pursuant to Section 11 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in DA2012-43,² and granted AltaGas Holdings Inc. this approval to operate the power plant, subject to the provisions *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The power plant shall be located in LSD 5 of Section 5, Township 10, Range 19, west of the Fourth Meridian.
2. The power plant shall consist of six reciprocating gas engines with a total generating capacity of 6.4 megawatts (MW) and continue to be operated in accordance with Application No. 2001132.
3. AltaGas Holdings Inc. shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any material changes to the power plant or substantially varying the design and/or specifications of the power plant from what was stated in the application or from what was approved in Approval No. U2007-243.
4. This approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

5. If the sale of the power plant does not proceed as indicated in the application, this approval shall be null and void.

Approval No. U2007-243 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this approval, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this approval, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.

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
