Maxim Power Corp. (Maxim), pursuant to Connection Order No. [U2007-250](#),¹ has approval to connect the Fort MacLeod power plant in the Fort MacLeod, Alberta area to the distribution system of FortisAlberta.

By Application No. 1608114 registered on February 1, 2012, AltaGas Holdings Inc., as a partner of AltaGas Pipeline Partnership, notified the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) that Maxim agreed to sell the power plant to AltaGas Pipeline Partnership pursuant to an Asset Acquisition Agreement dated January 25, 2012. AltaGas Holdings Inc. applied to hold the power plant connection order in its name.

Pursuant to Section 18 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, the Commission approved the application in DA2012-43,² and granted AltaGas Holdings Inc. this order to connect the power plant to the distribution system, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. AltaGas Holdings Inc. may connect the power plant to the distribution system in LSD 5, Section 30, Township 9, Range 25, west of the Fourth Meridian, as indicated in the application.
2. The specifications of the connection shall be as set out in Application. No. 2001130.
3. The connection shall be operated so that except under short-term emergency conditions:
 - a) The flows of real and reactive power are those for which the connection is designed and which it is intended to carry on a continuous basis.
 - b) No excessive surges of 60-hertz power or excessive exchange of power frequency harmonics shall occur between the systems connected.
4. This order is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

5. If the sale of the power plant does not proceed as indicated in the application, this connection order shall be null and void.

Connection Order No. U2007-250 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this order, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this order, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.

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
