ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1609207 registered on January 18, 2013 (the application), filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Township 55, Range 22 west of the Fourth Meridian for:

- Mapping amendment of Line 13.
- Addition of unlicensed abandoned pipeline (Line 25).

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 15164.

ATCO stated that after reviewing its records it was determined that line number 13 was incorrectly mapped when the line was permitted in July 1988. It was also determined that during the installation of line number 13, 30 metres of pipeline was abandoned in place. The addition of abandoned line number 25 to licence 15164 will correct the record for this licence.

In its submission, ATCO also stated that the pipeline was abandoned in accordance with AUC requirements, all associated surface facilities were removed and the surface sites were reclaimed within one year.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
