## Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1609578 registered on May 7, 2013, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the Pipeline Act and Section 4.1 of the Gas Utilities Act for the following in Township 9, Range 12, west of the Fourth Meridian:

- $\mathrm{H}_{2} \mathrm{~S}$ content amendment from $0.10 \mathrm{~mol} / \mathrm{kmol}$ to $0.00 \mathrm{~mol} / \mathrm{kmol}$.
- Mapping amendment of Line 1.

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence No. 3807.

ATCO stated that, while reviewing their records, it was determined that a typing error had occurred on the permit showing the $\mathrm{H}_{2} \mathrm{~S}$ content for License 3807 as $0.1 \mathrm{~mol} / \mathrm{kmol}$, when the permit should have read $0.0 \mathrm{~mol} / \mathrm{kmol}$. ATCO also stated that the pipeline was mapped incorrectly and proposed to adjust the base map to accurately reflect the correct length of the pipeline.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
