**Minor Pipeline Alignment Change
Permit and Licence No. 16723
Application No. 1609743
Proceeding ID No. 2711**

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1609743, registered on July 9, 2013, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Township 54, Range 16, west of the Fourth Meridian:

- pipeline alignment of Line 110
- length amendment of Line 110
- mapping amendment of Line 110

The proposed amendment is related to facilities recently approved under Permit and Licence No. 16723.

ATCO stated that the original pipeline route deviated slightly to accommodate a transmission power line pole that was proposed in 2-54-16-W4M. The alignment of the transmission line has changed, and an affected landowner has requested a revision to the pipeline route so that the line will extend linearly through his property.

ATCO has provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the project. Since the project involves no significant ground disturbance, the resultant environmental impact of the work has been assessed with no significant impact identified. The landowner and occupant of the affected lands did not object to the project.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no person other than the landowner and occupant of the land upon which the project takes place will likely be directly affected by the proposal and no significant adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed project.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
