


Miscellaneous Gas Rate Order U2006-122

ATCO Gas North Amendment to Rider “B” with respect to the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo	Application No. 1451247

ATCO Gas North, a division of ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO Gas North) applied to the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (the EUB) for an Order approving the addition of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo to Rate Rider “B” which recovers municipal taxes.

Notice of the application was published in conjunction with the Notice for the Regional Municipality’s application for renewal of its franchise agreement with ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. and no objections were received. ATCO Gas North has given the EUB consent to proceed with the application without a hearing.

The Board notes that this change in rates result from the provisions included in the franchise agreement between the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. which was approved in Order U2006-121 issued in conjunction with this order.

The Alberta Energy and Utilities Board, pursuant to the *Gas Utilities Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. G-5, hereby orders as follows:

1. Application No. 1451247 by ATCO Gas North dated March 9, 2006, is approved, subject to the terms and conditions herein contained.
2. The new rate for the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo, as indicated on Rate Rider “B” attached as Schedule “A” to this Order, becomes effective upon the execution of the Regional Municipality’s Franchise Renewal Agreement with ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd.

**ATCO GAS AND PIPELINES LTD. – NORTH
ATCO GAS – NORTH AND ATCO PIPELINES - NORTH
RIDER "B" TO ALL RATES
AND ANY OTHER RIDERS THERETO**

This Rider is applicable to Customers resident in municipalities that receive a property tax under the Municipal Government Act or receive payment for specific costs which are not generally incurred by the Company. This Rider is the estimated percentage of gross revenue required to provide for the tax payable or specific cost incurred each year. To the extent that this percentage may be more or less than that required to pay the tax or specific cost, the percentage of gross revenue provided in the Rider will be adjusted on the 1st of February each year.

The percentage is to be applied as an addition to the billings calculated under the Rates including charges as allowed under other Riders in effect with respect to the following municipalities:
