Amendment to Permits and Licences No. 9416 and No. 9417 Application No. 1608072 Proceeding ID No. 1681

## **Record amendment application**

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1608072 registered on January 23, 2012, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Township 52, Range 22, west of the Fourth Meridian:

- To change the status of Line 37 of Permit and Licence No. 9416 from "Operating" to "Abandoned".
- To change the status of Line 39 of Permit and Licence No. 9417 from "Operating" to "Abandoned".

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permits and Licences No. 9416 and No. 9417.

ATCO stated that in 2008 approval was granted under Applications No. 1592274 and No. 1592351 for a pipeline project to proceed. The project was completed and the physical abandonments of the replaced portions were completed. ATCO determined that the subsequent abandonment notification application was not filed within the 90 days allowed by the AUC.

ATCO has provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permits and licences are attached.
