Pipeline Near De Winton Licence 11252 Proceeding 22134 Application 22134-A001

Record amendment

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 22134-A001 registered on October 31, 2016, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following near De Winton:
 - pipe status amendment of line 4 from operating to removed
 - mapping amendment of line 4
- 2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 11252.
- 3. ATCO stated that it received approval from the AUC to replace an existing 60.3-millimetre pipeline with a 114.3-millimetre pipeline to accommodate the increased natural gas demand in the De Winton region. That approval, which involved new construction and a record amendment under Proceeding 2018, Decision 2012-224, indicated that line 4 was to be abandoned in place. At the time of construction ATCO decided, due to the extensive work being done at the site, that removing line 4 would be a better alternative.
- 4. ATCO stated that after reviewing its records, it was determined that line 4 of Licence 11252 was removed in June of 2013. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licence in order to accurately reflect the record of this pipeline.
- 5. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Decision 2012-224: ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) – New Construction, Township 21, Range 29, West of the Fourth Meridian, Proceeding 2018, Application 1608621, August 17, 2012.

- 6. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
- 7. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
