ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1608157 registered on February 13, 2012, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Township 25, Range 2, west of the Fifth Meridian:

- Reinstatement of a portion of Line 2 as Abandoned Line 5.
- Length adjustment to Removed Line 2.

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 6353.

ATCO stated that it applied for the removal of Line 2 in Application No. 1607437. Upon review of the as built information, it was determined that a 20-metre portion of 42 millimetre pipeline was left abandoned in place and could not be removed at the time of construction.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
