ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1608203 registered on February 27, 2012, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following record amendments in Townships 24 and 25, Ranges 2, 3, 4 and 5 west of the Fifth Meridian:

- Addition of a record for a portion of pipeline previously removed from the licence (Line 51 – 0.13 kilometres of 323.9 millimetre outside-diameter pipeline).
- Add environmental code “XA” to Line 37 to reflect that a replacement occurred on Line 37.
- Remove environmental code “XA” from Line 9 to reflect that a replacement on Line 9 did not occur.
- Mapping amendment of Line 37.

The proposed amendments relate to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 1952. ATCO proposed to add Line 51 regarding the portion of pipeline removed during a 1972 relocation, complete a mapping correction on Line 37, remove the XA code from Line 9 and add the XA code to Line 37.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
