Amendment to Permit and Licence No. 9414 Application No. 1608361 Proceeding ID No. 1853

## **Record amendment application**

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1608361 registered on April 24, 2012, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to re-instate a portion of Line 37 as abandoned Line 41 in Township 52, Range 23, west of the Fourth Meridian. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 9414.

ATCO stated that in 2008 they filed Application No. 1567814 to remove Line 37. Upon review of the as built information, it was determined that a 70-metre portion of abandoned line could not be removed from under the roadway and was abandoned in place.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
