Amendment to Permit and Licence 25935 Application No. 1608411 Proceeding ID No. 1860

Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1608411 registered on May 2, 2012 (the application), filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to delete Line 3 from Licence 25935, in Townships 49 and 50, Range 5 west of the Fourth Meridian, in order to effect the transfer of Line 3 from ATCO to Spur Resources Ltd. (Spur). The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 25935.

ATCO stated that they have previously discontinued this pipeline and have no future plans for its use. Spur has requested to purchase this line to enhance their system within this area.

ATCO also stated that ATCO and Spur have a signed purchase and sales agreement with the approval of the transfer from the AUC being part of the final process to complete the transfer. Upon approval from the AUC, ATCO would proceed to transfer the pipeline within the ERCB DDS system to complete the transaction. Spur would receive a new ERCB license and line number at that point for Line 3 of Licence 25935. Upon the acceptance from the ERCB, ATCO would notify the AUC.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
