Amendment to Permit and Licence No. 5229 Application No. 1608615 Proceeding ID No. 1997

Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1608615 registered on July 4, 2012, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following amendments in, Township 83, Range 22, west of the Fifth Meridian:

- splitting Line 2 into Lines 2 and 20
- abandonment of Line 20
- Line 2 is to remain in operation
- length and mapping correction of Line 19

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 5229.

ATCO Pipelines Application No. 1608235, for minor removal and replacement of an existing 114 millimetre high pressure sweet natural gas pipeline crossing, was approved March 14, 2012, by DA 2012-66. Line 17 was removed as per the original application. However, Line 19 was lengthened from what was approved in order to avoid a wetland area. To correct the record Line 2 must be split further into Line 2 and Line 20, with Line 20 abandoned in place.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

DA2012-66: ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) Amendment to accommodate grading at the request of Alberta Transportation – Minor pipeline project application, Application No. 1608235, Proceeding ID No. 1763, March 14, 2012.
