Amendment to Permit and Licence No. 103 Application No. 1608798 Proceeding ID No. 2110

Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1608798 registered on September 6, 2012, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to delete lines 17 and 18 from the licence in Township 49, Range 7, west of the Fifth Meridian. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 103.

ATCO stated that lines 17 and 18 are distribution lines operating at a maximum pressure below 700 kilopascals. Therefore, licensing of these lines is not required.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
