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1 Introduction

1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO) filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) seeking approval for an amendment to Permit and Licence 5797 pursuant to Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following:

- pipe grade substitution for Line 6, Line 7 and Line 8

(the project)

2. The application was registered on February 18, 2011 as Application No. 1607038 (the application).

3. ATCO stated that the grade of pipe delivered by the supplier was actually grade 359 rather than grade 292, as originally specified in application 1606743. The pipe substituted was of a higher grade; however, there was no cost adjustment for the substitution. Therefore, an amendment to the permit and licence is necessary to reflect accurate information on the pipeline licence.

2 Findings

4. The Commission has reviewed the application and determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in AUC Rule 020: *Rules Respecting Gas Utility Pipelines*.

5. Based on the foregoing, the Commission considers the project to be in the public interest in accordance with Section 17 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.

3 Decision

6. Pursuant to Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, the Commission approves the amendment to Permit and Licence 5797 for the project and grants ATCO the amended permit and licence as set out in Appendix 1 – Amendment – Permit and Licence No. 5797 – March 7, 2011 (Appendix 1 will be distributed separately).
