1 Introduction

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO) filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) seeking approval for an amendment to Permit and Licence No. 6458 pursuant to Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following:
 - add missing Stress Level to Line 2

(the amendment).

- 2. The application was registered on April 26, 2011, as Application No. 1607240.
- 3. ATCO stated that the amendment is necessary to reflect accurate information on the pipeline licence.

2 Findings

- 4. The Commission finds that the above noted amendment is necessary to maintain the pipeline data base that reflects actual pipeline operations.
- 5. The Commission has reviewed the application and determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in AUC Rule 020: *Rules Respecting Gas Utility Pipelines*.
- 6. Based on the foregoing, the Commission considers the amendment to be in the public interest in accordance with Section 17 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.

3 Decision

7. Pursuant to Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, the Commission approves the amendment to Permit and Licence No. 6458 and grants ATCO the amended permit and licence as set out in Appendix 1 – Permit and Licence No. 6458 – May 12, 2011 (Appendix 1 will be distributed separately).
