Amendment to Reflect Accurate Information on the Pipeline Licence Application No. 1607610 Proceeding ID No. 1411

## **Record amendment application**

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1607610 registered on August 24, 2011 (the application), filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to reinstate a portion of the original Line 66, which is underneath a road and could not be removed, as abandoned Line 78 in Township 6, Ranges 20 and 21, west of the Fourth Meridian. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 2354.

The Commission notes that ATCO has provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment did not involve a ground disturbance, there was no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
