Amendment to Reflect Accurate Information on the Pipeline Licence Permit and Licence No. 2027 – September 26, 2011 Amendment Application No. 1607675 Proceeding ID No. 1450

Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1607675 registered on September 19, 2011, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to change a portion of removed Line 139, in Township 17, Range 28, west of the Fourth Meridian, to Line 142 with the status as "Abandoned", and amend the length of Line 139. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 2027.

The Commission notes that ATCO has provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
