ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1607886 registered on November 14, 2011, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to transfer an existing pipeline (Line 62 – 0.61 kilometres (km) of 114.3-millimetre (mm) outside-diameter (OD) pipeline) in Township 29, Range 22 west of the Fourth Meridian from AUC Permit and Licence No. 106 to Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB) Licence No. 53523.

ATCO stated that the pipeline transfer from AUC Permit and Licence No. 106 to ERCB Licence No. 53523 was already completed by the ERCB on August 31, 2011. The AUC considers that while the pipeline was added to ERCB Licence No. 53523, it could not be deleted from AUC Permit and Licence No. 106 without AUC approval. Deletion of the pipeline is the matter being corrected by this application to the AUC.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application.
