ATCO GAS AND PIPELINES LTD. (SOUTH)
AMENDMENT/ADDITION TO ACCOMMODATE
CONSTRUCTION AT THE ALBIAN SANDS MINE SITE

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (the Applicant) filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (the Commission) seeking approval for an amendment/addition to Permit/Licence 34093 for the following:
 - Mapping correction of Lines 10 and 3
 - Splitting Line 10 into Lines 10, 12, and 13
 - Removal of Line 12
 - Addition of a newly constructed pipeline (Line 14 120 m of 406.4mm OD pipe)

(the Project).

2 BACKGROUND

- 2. The application was registered on February 9, 2010, as Application 1605886 (the Application).
- 3. The Applicant stated that the amendment/addition was necessary to accommodate Shell's request to replace a segment of the existing 406mm OD pipeline with heavy wall pipe to ensure line safety. Shell is proposing to construct a "heavy haul road" on top of the existing pipeline at the Albian Sands mine site.

3 DISCUSSION

- 4. The Commission has reviewed the Application and has determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in *AUC Rule 020*. The Commission notes that a participant involvement program has been conducted by the Applicant and that there are no outstanding public or industry objections or concerns.
- 5. Since no parties objected to the Application and the Project is necessary for the construction of a heavy haul road in the Albian Sands mine site, the Commission considers the Project to be in the public interest.

4 DECISION

6. Therefore, pursuant to section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, the Commission approves the amendment/addition to Permit/Licence 34093 for the Project and grants the Applicant the amended Permit/Licence as set out in Appendix 1 – Gas Utility Pipeline: Pipeline Split, Replacement and Mapping Correction – Permit/Licence No. 34093 – February 22, 2010 (Appendix 1 will be distributed separately).
