Addition of an Existing Unlicenced Pipeline Near Kinsella Proceeding 22325 Application 22325-A001

## **Record amendment application**

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 22325-A001 registered on January 12, 2017, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to obtain a new licence for an existing operating pipeline (line 1 0.09 kilometres of 26.7-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline).
- 2. ATCO stated that in 1970, it installed a 90-metre long, 26.7-millimetre high pressure natural gas lateral pipeline to provide natural gas service to a new distribution customer. Upon review of its records it discovered that the lateral pipeline was not licensed.
- 3. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 4. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
- 5. The Commission approves the application and grants a new licence to be issued pending pipeline database updates.
