**Addition of an Existing Unlicensed Pipeline Near Kinsella  
Proceeding 22325  
Application 22325-A001**

**Record amendment application**

1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 22325-A001 registered on January 12, 2017, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to obtain a new licence for an existing operating pipeline (line 1 – 0.09 kilometres of 26.7-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline).
2. ATCO stated that in 1970, it installed a 90-metre long, 26.7-millimetre high pressure natural gas lateral pipeline to provide natural gas service to a new distribution customer. Upon review of its records it discovered that the lateral pipeline was not licensed.
3. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
4. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
5. The Commission approves the application and grants a new licence to be issued pending pipeline database updates.
