#### 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO) is the holder of Pipeline License 2526 issued on July 8, 2010, which approved the construction and operation of a gas utility pipeline from 09-31-042-25 W4M to 09-31-042-25 W4M. ATCO filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or Commission) under section 35(2) of the *Pipeline Regulation* pursuant to the *Pipeline Act*. ATCO is seeking approval to conduct a hydrostatic test of the 168.3 mm OD pipeline portion under the Battle River using a 60/40 water-methanol mix as the test medium.
- 2. The application was registered on November 22, 2010, as Application 1606760 (Application). The reason for the request to use a 60/40 water-methanol mix is that the hydrostatic test is required to be performed during cold ambient temperatures.
- 3. ATCO submitted descriptions of the proposed test medium, the proposed containment methods, including control points and available equipment in the event of a spill, and the time to initiate containment procedures as required by section 35(2) of the *Pipeline Regulation*. ATCO also stated that an environmental inspector would be on site for the duration of the hydrostatic test.

#### 2 DISCUSSION

4. The Commission has reviewed the Application and has determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in *AUC Rule 020*. Since a hydrostatic test with a water-methanol mix is necessary to prevent freezing of the medium, the Commission considers the Application to be in the public interest.

#### 3 DECISION

5. The Commission approves the use of a 60/40 water-methanol mix for the hydrostatic test of the 168.3mm OD pipeline crossing Battle River, according to section 35 of the *Pipeline Regulation* made pursuant to the *Pipeline Act*.
