1 INTRODUCTION

1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (the Applicant) filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (the Commission) seeking approval for an amendment to Permit/Licence 6419 for the following: (the Project)

- Re-instatement of Lines 2, 15 and 26.

2 BACKGROUND

2. The application was registered on August 21, 2009, as Application 1605379 (the Application).

3. The Applicant stated that the amendment/addition was necessary to correct the Commission records. The proposed changes to the licence reflect modifications to the ATCO Pipelines Redwater Transmission and Redwater Field (Opal) systems undertaken in September 2008.

3 DISCUSSION

4. The Commission has reviewed the Application and has determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in AUC Rule 020. The Commission notes that a participant involvement program has been conducted by the Applicant and that there are no outstanding public or industry objections or concerns.

5. Lines 2 and 26 are road crossing sections of the original Line 2 and Line 15 respectively, both pipeline sections are abandoned in place.

6. Line 15 (a portion of the original Line 15), as per landowners instructions, is a pipeline left in service to maintain supply to an existing delivery facility.

7. Since no parties objected to the Application and the Project is necessary to correct the Commission records and to reflect modifications to the ATCO Pipelines Redwater Transmission and Redwater Field (Opal) systems undertaken in September 2008, the Commission considers the Project to be in the public interest.

4 DECISION

8. Therefore, Pursuant to section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, the Commission approves the amendment to Permit/Licence 6419 for the Project and grants the Applicant the amended Permit/Licence as set out in Appendix 1 – Pipeline Re-instatement – Permit/Licence No. 6419 – September 10, 2009 (Appendix 1 will be distributed separately).
