#### 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (the Applicant) filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (the Commission) seeking approval for an amendment/addition to Permit/Licence 10844 for the following: (the Project)
  - Length and location corrections of Line 2.
  - Splitting Line 2 into Lines 2, 6 and 7.
  - Removal of Line 6.
  - Addition of newly constructed pipeline (Line 8 120 m of 60.3mm OD pipe).

#### 2 BACKGROUND

- 2. The application was registered on September 4, 2009, as Application 1605416 (the Application).
- 3. The Applicant stated that the amendment/addition was necessary to meet the required depth of the pipeline across a Western Irrigation District (WID) canal.

#### 3 DISCUSSION

- 4. The Commission has reviewed the Application and has determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in AUC Rule 020. The Commission notes that a participant involvement program has been conducted by the Applicant and that there are no outstanding public or industry objections or concerns.
- 5. Since no parties objected to the Application and the Project is necessary to meet the required depth of the pipeline across a WID canal, the Commission considers the Project to be in the public interest.

#### 4 DECISION

6. Therefore, pursuant to section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, the Commission approves the amendment/addition to Permit/Licence 10844 for the Project and grants the Applicant the amended Permit/Licence as set out in Appendix 1 – Pipeline Split, Record Corrections and Replacement – Permit/Licence No. 10844 – September 14, 2009 (Appendix 1 will be distributed separately).
