ATCO GAS AND PIPELINES LTD. (SOUTH) AMENDMENT/ADDITION TO ACCOMMODATE RANGE ROAD 55 UPGRADE

Decision 2009-147 Application No. 1605458

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (the Applicant) filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (the Commission) seeking approval for an amendment/addition to Permit/Licence 18185 for the following: (the Project)
 - Splitting Line 2 into Lines 2, 17, and 18.
 - Removal of Line 17.
 - Addition of two newly constructed pipelines (Line 19 70 m of 114.3mm OD pipe and Line 20 10 m of 60.3mm OD pipe).

2 BACKGROUND

- 2. The application was registered on September 17, 2009, as Application 1605458 (the Application).
- 3. The Applicant stated that the amendment/addition was necessary to accommodate Alberta Transportation's upgrade of Range Road 55 as part of Hwy 43 upgrade project. The Applicant has been asked to lower a portion of its 114mm OD Glen Leslie Transmission to accommodate the upgrade.
- 4. The Applicant will also construct 10m of 60mm OD pipeline to feed the existing ATCO Gas regulator station.

3 DISCUSSION

- 5. The Commission has reviewed the Application and has determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in AUC Rule 020. The Commission notes that a participant involvement program has been conducted by the Applicant and that there are no outstanding public or industry objections or concerns.
- 6. Since no parties objected to the Application and the Project is necessary to accommodate Range Road 55 upgrade, the Commission considers the Project to be in the public interest.

4 DECISION

7. Therefore, Pursuant to section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, the Commission approves the amendment/addition to Permit/Licence 18185 for the Project and grants the Applicant the amended Permit/Licence as set out in Appendix 1 - Pipeline Split, Removal and New Construction – Permit/Licence No. 18185 – September 24, 2009 (Appendix 1 will be distributed separately).
