ATCO GAS AND PIPELINES LTD. (SOUTH) AMENDMENT TO ACCOMMODATE THE PROPOSED LAND DEVELOPMENT IN THE SCOTFORD INDUSTRIAL AREA

#### 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (the Applicant) filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (the Commission) seeking approval for an amendment to Permit/Licence 15386 for the following: (the Project)
  - Abandonment of Lines 1 and 2.

### 2 BACKGROUND

- 2. The application was registered on November 6, 2009, as Application 1605610 (the Application).
- 3. The Applicant stated that the amendment was necessary to accommodate the proposed land development in the Scotford industrial area.
- 4. In 2008, the Applicant completed a pipeline relocation project upon request of industrial landowners in the Scotland industrial area. The current location of this pipeline conflicts with landowners' development plans.

#### 3 DISCUSSION

- 5. The Commission has reviewed the Application and has determined that it meets the requirements as stipulated in AUC Rule 020. The Commission notes that a participant involvement program has been conducted and understands that there are no outstanding public or industry objections or concerns.
- 6. Since no parties objected to the application and the Project is necessary to accommodate the proposed land development, the Commission considers the Project to be in the public interest.

#### 4 DECISION

7. Therefore, Pursuant to section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, the Commission approves the amendment to Permit/Licence 15386 for the Project and grants the Applicant the amended Permit/Licence as set out in the Appendix 1: Gas Utility

Pipeline – Pipeline Abandonment – Permit/Licence No. 15386 – November 19, 2009 (Appendix 1 will be distributed separately).
