## **Record amendment application**

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 22401-A001, registered on February 8, 2017, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following:
  - splitting of line 2 into lines 2 and 3
  - pipe status amendment of line 3 from operating to abandoned
  - mapping amendment of line 2
- 2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 32196.
- 3. ATCO stated that in 2012 it completed a project involving the addition of an in-line inspection tool launching facility at an existing compressor site. The new piping was expected to be installed wholly within the surface lease and therefore a licence application was not submitted. During construction, ATCO determined that a 40-metre segment of pipe, line 3, was required to be abandoned in place, thereby requiring an amendment to the licence.
- 4. ATCO stated that all liquids contained in the pipe were captured and disposed of prior to the abandonment activities.
- 5. ATCO stated that the application for abandonment is not within the 90-day period allowed under Section 82(2) of the *Pipeline Rules* listed under *Alberta Regulation* 91/2005 pursuant to the *Pipeline Act*.
- 6. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

- 7. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
- 8. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
