Pipeline near Athabasca Licence 203 Proceeding 22402 Application 22402-A001

Record amendment application

- 1. AltaGas Utilities Inc. (AltaGas), by Application 22402-A001, registered on February 8, 2017, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the status of line 37, near Athabasca, from discontinued to abandoned. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operated in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 203.
- 2. AltaGas stated that the location of line 37 is within a right-of-way owned by Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL). CNRL has requested that the line be abandoned in order to accommodate its future construction plans.
- 3. AltaGas provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 4. Based upon the information provided, AltaGas has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

5. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
