Pipeline near Fort Saskatchewan Licence 6419 Proceeding 22466 Application 22466-A001

Record amendment application

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application 22466-A001, registered on March 8, 2017, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following within Sturgeon County:
 - length amendment of line 19 from 0.83 kilometres (km) to the revised length of 0.97 km
 - 'From Location' and 'To Location' LSD amendment of line 19
 - 'From Location' and 'To Location' Section amendment of line 19
 - mapping amendment of line 19
- 2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 6419.
- 3. ATCO stated that after reviewing its "As Built" records, it was determined that the licence did not reflect the correct length and location of line 19. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licence and base map to accurately reflect the record of this pipeline.
- 4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendments do not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 5. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
