Compressor Station Near Lloydminster Licence 25935 Proceeding 22926 Application 22926-A001

## **Record amendment application**

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by Application 22926-A001 registered on September 6, 2017, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to add a compressor station to Licence 25935 near Lloydminster. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in facility Licence F-26189.
- 2. ATCO stated that a recent review of its records indicated that a compressor station installed in 2001 was incorrectly licenced under facility Licence F-26189 and should have been licenced as a pipeline installation. In addition, the legal subdivision location was incorrectly identified as Legal Subdivision 3 on the facility licence and should have been identified as Legal Subdivision 4. ATCO proposed to re-licence the compressor station as Installation 009 of Licence 25935 with the correct legal subdivision location.
- 3. ATCO stated that upon approval of this application, it would apply for the removal of the compressor station under a subsequent application.
- 4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 5. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
