Pipeline Near Calgary Licence 1952 Proceeding 23129 Application 23129-A001

Record amendment

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by Application 23129-A001, registered on November 23, 2017, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following near Calgary:
 - pipe wall thickness amendment of lines 82 and 84 from 8.40 millimetres to 7.10 millimetres
 - environmental code amendment of line 75 from blank to creek crossing (CC)
 - environmental code amendment of line 79 from blank to river crossing (RC)
- 2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 1952.
- 3. ATCO stated that after reviewing its records, it was determined that the licence did not reflect the correct wall thickness of lines 82 and 84 and environmental codes of lines 75 and 79. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licence to accurately reflect the record of these pipelines.
- 4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 5. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
