Record amendment

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by Application 23616-A001, registered on June 4, 2018, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following near the city of Calgary:
 - length amendment of line 5 from 1.00 kilometres to the revised length of 1.13 kilometres
 - length amendment of line 6 from 1.21 kilometres to the revised length of 1.16 kilometres
 - length amendment of line 9 from 0.53 kilometres to the revised length of 0.45 kilometres
- 2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 1594.
- 3. ATCO stated that after reviewing its as-built information, it was determined that the licence did not reflect the correct length of lines 5, 6 and 9. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licence to accurately reflect the record of these pipelines.
- 4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 5. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
