## **Record amendment application**

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by Application 23679-A001 registered on June 21, 2018, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the wall thickness of line 9. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 6306.
- 2. ATCO stated that this application is to correct the licenced wall thickness from 3.90 millimetres to 4.0 millimetres on line 9 of Licence 6306 constructed under Decision 22884-D01-2017. The change is required to ensure the licenced wall thickness corresponds to the CSA Z245.1 convention for wall thickness dimensions.
- 3. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 4. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
