Pipelines within Beaver County Licences 9413 and 9414 Proceeding 23746 Applications 23746-A001 and 23746-A002

## **Record amendment application**

1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by applications 23746-A001 and 23746-A002 registered on July 17, 2018, filed applications with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following:

## Pertaining to Licence 9413:

- splitting of previously abandoned line 20 into lines 20, 98 and 99
- removal of line 98
- wall thickness amendment of original line 20 from 9.99 millimetres to 6.35 millimetres
- lines 20 and 99 are to remain abandoned in place

## Pertaining to Licence 9414:

- splitting of previously abandoned line 11 into lines 11, 71 and 72
- removal of line 71
- wall thickness amendment of original line 11 from 9.53 millimetres to 6.35 millimetres
- lines 11 and 72 are to remain abandoned in place
- 2. The proposed amendments are related to facilities previously constructed in accordance with approvals granted in licences 9413 and 9414.
- 3. ATCO stated that, after reviewing its "As Built" records, it was determined that 20 metres of line 20 under Licence 9413 and 20 metres of line 11 under Licence 9414 were removed without making an adjustment to the licences. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licences to accurately reflect the record of these pipelines.
- 4. ATCO stated that landowners and occupants were provided notification at the time of the removal in accordance with Rule 020: *Rules Respecting Gas Utility Pipelines*.

- 5. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendments. Since the record amendments do not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 6. Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendments.
- 7. The Commission approves the applications. The amended licences are attached.
